Aslan has a thyroid problem which is not a big deal health wise, but he does need daily medication made up by the compounding pharmacist. His current owner can tell you more about this. He is desexed, microchipped and vaccinated.

Aslan is a big dog and will need high fences in good condition at his new home. In his current home, he's been escaping a fenced off area they built for him, but he only escapes to come and sit on the back step.



Zara is an 18 month old Kelpie who's looking for a home where she will be included as part of the family.


She is very affectionate and a smart cookie. She'd love an owner who would take her out and about with the family to exercise her mind as well as her muscles.

RANDY IS LOOKING FOR A NEW HOME


Randy is a purebred six year old German Shepherd looking for a new home through no fault of his own. He has good basic obedience and knows sit, stay, inside/outside, lay down. He is ball obsessed and loves to chase and bring the ball back.

Randy is toilet trained and is an inside dog whenever his owner is home. He doesn't cope very well if left alone for long periods. He's looking for an owner who is home at least some of the time during the week or who can take him to work with them.

Randy is very affectionate towards his family, but he needs careful introductions to people he doesn't know. It's the same when he meets new dogs. He can be anxious on first meeting, but is ok once he gets to know them. Out on a walk he will bark and pull if he sees another dog, but if he is allowed to get close, he just wants to say hello. He does sometimes go to the dog park, but he can find it a bit much, so quiet times are best.

On lead, Randy pulls at the beginning of a walk, but soon settles down if reminded. He would suit and active owner who has time to give him a good walk each day. He is desexed, microchipped, vaccinated and has no hip or elbow problems. BEAUTIFUL BUSTER NEEDS A NEW HOME


