If you're an active family or you're looking for a running partner, then Pink could be the dog for you. Pink is a sweet 7 year old German Shepherd with tons of energy.

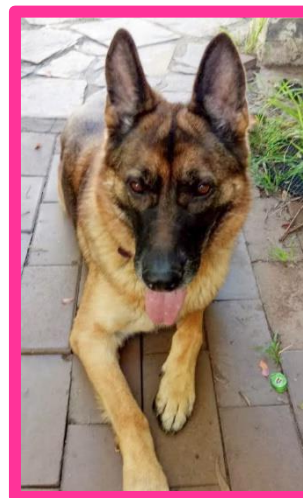

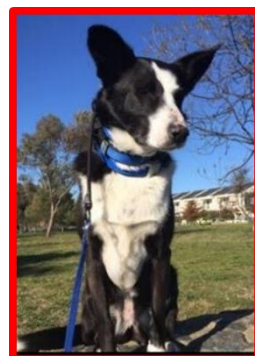
LOVELY LUCY NEEDS A GREAT NEW HOME
