ORION NEEDS A NEW HOME

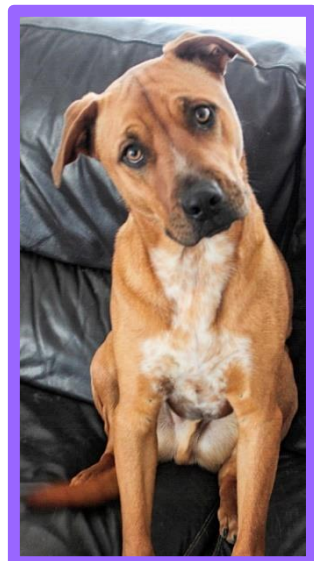
Orion is an 18-month-old mystery mix breed. He is looking for an experienced owner to provide him with the training to help him become a happy and settled family pet.
