Hi There

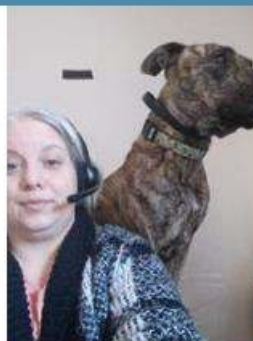
